We're glad you will be joining us for **Counselor Training 2008.**

Here are some things you should know before you come to camp:

- Counselor Training is an intensive training experience and a lot of fun. The training takes place in small groups and touches on many topics including human relation skills, group dynamics, and safety issues at camp. Counselors are selected on the basis of their full participation in the training program, their ability to act responsibly, their willingness to be a role model and leader, and their enthusiasm for working with children.
- The session will begin with dinner at 5:30 p.m. on **Sunday, June 22nd** (please arrive by 5:00 p.m.), and conclude at 1:00 p.m. **Tuesday July 1st**.
- An important part of the camp experience is living simply and in harmony with the natural surroundings, so please leave radios, hair dryers, electronic games, and all other electrical appliances at home. Please leave all food, candy, and gum at home also as the camp provides tasty meals with plenty of food, a snack every afternoon, and all of the fruit you can possibly want. You will be able to go into Julian during free time most days so you may want to bring a little money.
- Cell phones are not alarm clocks and should be off and put away until your two hours of free time.
- **Possession of illegal drugs, alcohol, or weapons will result in immediate removal from camp.**
- Smoking is not permitted at camp.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Check the registration information carefully. Correct any errors and fill in any missing information and return it with the items in the next section as soon as possible to:

- Medical Information Form:** *We must have the Parent/Guardian Section, the Authorization & Consent to Treatment section, and the Camper/Parent/Guardian Section Completed. Please make a copy of the form for your records, and return the original to Camp Stevens.* We reserve the right, through our nurse, to refuse admission to anyone who does not have a medical form, or whose report indicates camping would be harmful to the camper's health or to the health of others, is not physically able to participate, or who is ill upon arrival at camp. Certain medical conditions or campers/staff persons under a doctor's care (see front of Medical Information Form) will require that we have a copy of a medical examination within the last two years for admission to camp. One medical form is good all summer, if the consent form is dated through September of 2008.
- Ropes Course Release.** Please sign the enclosed participation form for the ropes course and have your parent sign the release section of that form. While we may not be doing the ropes course during counselor training, we will have the form on file should you counsel for a session using the ropes course.

PERSONAL ITEMS such as clothes and gear should be camp friendly, meaning old clothes for outside wear which will probably get dirty. Please be sure that all of your belongings are well marked. Please do not bring any valuables along, as the camp cannot be held responsible for these items.

ASSIGNMENTS for counseling will be made at the end of Counselor Training for applicants who have demonstrated the appropriate skills and maturity for the position.

Please bring your summer schedule with you to camp to indicate the weeks you are available.

CANCELLATIONS: If you must cancel, please contact the Registrar as soon as possible. Cancellations made by phone must also be confirmed in writing.

- 1) Received at least 15 days before the sessions begins receive full refund **less deposit.**
- 2) Received 2-14 days prior = 50% refund.
- 3) Received less than 2 days prior to the session = **no refund** except in medical emergencies when 50% will be refunded. A \$20.00 fee will be applied for all returned checks.
